**CLOUDED LEOPARD** [*Neofelis nebulosa*]

Gary wanted to draw the Clouded Leopard particularly because of its markings. His aim in completing the drawing was to accentuate what he saw as the cat's best points - its markings, tail and face. He is particularly pleased with the tail. It is not the loveliest of cats but it is a really lovely study.

The Clouded Leopard falls between the big cats (it does not roar) and the small cats, sharing characteristics of both. It is secretive and elusive and is found in the forests of southern China and south-east Asia, to Sumatra and Borneo. It is heavily built with short legs and a long tail. It is particularly adept at climbing trees where it spends much of its time (and where it usually sleeps).

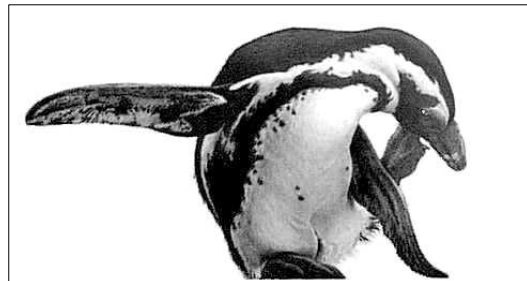
It can run down tree trunks headfirst and swing upside down on the underside of branches.

It is not known how seriously this cat is Endangered but it is thus listed.
