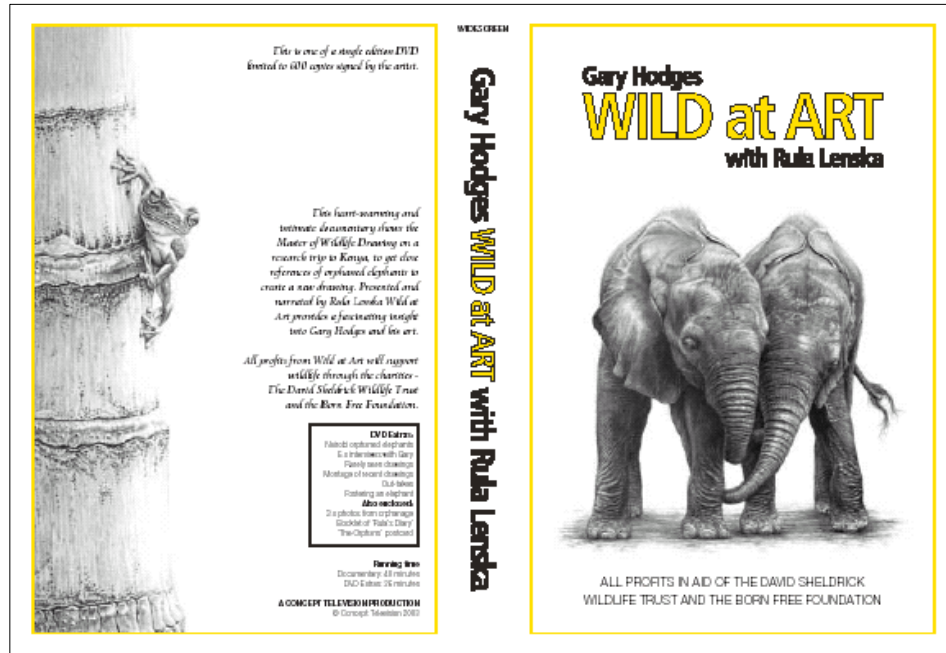


**ADDENDUM (No 6a)**

**DVD and VIDEO**

Gary visited the Daphne Sheldrick elephant orphanage and Tsavo East National Park in Kenya on a research trip, in 2002, with Rula Lenska. The main aim of the trip was to obtain close photographic references of young orphaned elephants for the creation of a new drawing. A documentary about the experience was produced by David Felber who had previously produced the “Drawn to Wildlife” Video. It is featured in a video and a DVD, both released in December 2003. Rula provides commentary and is filmed in discussion with Gary.

The unlimited video (£19.95) contains the documentary only.

The DVD (£50) is a limited edition of 600 copies, signed. It includes the documentary plus some additional footage and interviews with Gary, some of his old and rarely seen drawings, out-takes and details of elephant fostering. The package also includes three photos taken at the orphanage, a booklet and a postcard of “The Orphans”.

The print of “Joy” (see Addendum No 6) was a direct result of this experience. The development of the drawing is shown in the documentary. A second drawing is planned for some time in the future.

All profits from the sale of the video and DVD are to benefit the David Sheldrick Wildlife Trust and the Born Free Foundation.
